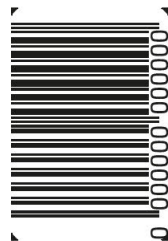

## ***HG laminate power cleaner*** ***(HG product 74)***

**HG "laminate power cleaner" is a powerful cleaner for the safe and fast removal of stubborn dirt, grease and protective films from all types of laminate.**

### **Directions:**

#### **For normal powerful cleaning:**

Dissolve one litre in half a bucket (5L) of lukewarm water and apply it with a wrung-out mop or floor cloth, regularly rinsing it in the solution. Do not rinse or mop dry, simply leave the floor to dry on its own.

#### **To remove HG "laminate protective coating gloss finish" (gloss coating) (HG product 70):**

Pour the undiluted product into a bucket and apply it using a wrung-out mop or floor cloth. Do not make the floor too wet (See Caution). Leave to penetrate for a few minutes and if required scrub with a scrubbing brush or stiff broom. Wipe up the liquid with a clean and wrung-out mop, regularly rinsing it in clean water. Finally, mop the floor once or twice again with a wrung-out mop and clean water.

#### **Coverage:**

± 10-15 m<sup>2</sup> per litre undiluted, ± 25-50 m<sup>2</sup> per litre diluted.

#### **Caution:**

Never make laminate too wet as that could cause the seams to swell up.
